Adoption Process

- The group leader or individual must complete and return *the Adoption Application and Commitment* form.
- City of Sheridan Parks Department staff will process your forms and contact you with your notice of approval.
- Once your adoption is approved, Park staff will meet with the individual or group leader for training and starter materials.
- All volunteers are required to read, understand, and abide by the Safety Guidelines in the handbook and must abide by all park rules and ordinances.
