

About the Sheridan Landfill

The Sheridan Landfill provides a place for the citizens of Sheridan County to dispose of their unwanted items. The landfill accepts household trash, construction debris, compost material, brush, tires, used oil, metal, clean concrete, asphalt, and Household Hazardous Waste. The facility also provides recycling activities for many of these items.

What We Do Each Year

- Grind an average of 1,000-1,500 tons of brush
- Bail and ship approximately 880 tons of scrap metal to recycling center
- Shipped approx. 17 tons of Household Hazardous Waste for proper disposal in 2013
- Compact and cover approximately 30,000 tons of household waste and construction debris

What to Expect During Your Landfill Visit

During your visit to the landfill, please follow the gate attendant's instructions, observe the speed limit and obey all traffic control lights. Please do not smoke while on site. Please observe all signage and yield to all equipment and landfill personnel.

Secured Load Ordinance

By City ordinance, all loads entering the landfill must be secured in such a manner that none of the load escapes the vehicle during transport. Examples of ways to secure loads include: rope, bungees, tie downs, tarps or cargo nets. For instance, a pickup carrying loose leaves in the bed would require a tarp and rope to be considered secure. Violation of the secured load ordinance will result in a \$10 per load fee for pickups a \$50 per load fee for large vehicles and trailers.


Landfill Fees

General Refuse	\$102/ton
Concrete (no rebar)	\$20/ton
Clean Pallets & Lumber	\$20/ton
Construction & Demolition Material	\$45/ton (grindable) \$102/ton (unable to be ground)
Tires	\$140/ton
Compost	\$30/ton (or pound-for-pound exchange for green waste)
Wood Chips	Coarse : \$5/cubic yd Medium: \$10/cubic yd Fine: \$15/cubic yd
Metal	Free
Green Waste	Free (must be free of rocks and debris and no larger than 24 inches in diameter)
Auto Batteries	\$0.0510/pound (minimum \$5.10)
Used Oil	Free (maximum 5 gallons per visit)
Animals	\$102/ton (wild game free during hunting season)
Poly Pipe	\$20/ton
All Other Material	\$102/ton
Cell Phones and Cell Batteries	\$0
Residential computers, televisions and computer monitors	\$0 (Commercial customers pay a fee—call 674-8461 for details)

Utility Bill (Landfill Pass)

Residents of the City of Sheridan who utilize city sanitation services are provided six landfill passes per calendar year. Each pass is valid for up to one ton of waste. The following items are not eligible for free pass use: batteries, tires, and Freon-containing appliances such as refrigerators and air conditioners. Please bring copy of utility (water or MDU) bill and valid ID to use this service.


