

PLASTIC 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Soda and detergent bottles ✓ Plastic milk, juice and water jugs ✓ All plastic containers numbered 1-7 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Rinse and clean ✓ Remove caps and covers (put in trash) ✓ Tie a knot in plastic bags to prevent wind from catching them 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✗ Motor oil or chemical containers ✗ Unclean flower pots ✗ Styrofoam (take to Recycling Center at 1148 KROE Lane) ✗ Packing Peanuts—take to UPS Store or Pack 'n Mail
GLASS 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Clear, green and brown glass food and beverage containers only 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Rinse and clean ✓ Collars, neck rings and labels OK ✓ Remove caps and put in trash 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✗ Corks ✗ Windshields ✗ Ceramics ✗ Window glass ✗ Mirrors ✗ Light bulbs
METAL 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Deposit and non-deposit aluminum beverage cans ✓ Metal food cans ✓ Aluminum trays and pie plates ✓ Clean aluminum foil 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Rinse and clean ✓ Remove labels if easy to remove ✓ Aluminum beverage cans must be placed in the "Aluminum" recycling bin ✓ All other cans must be placed in the "Tin & Steel" recycling bin 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✗ Paint cans ✗ Metal items ✗ Aerosol cans ✗ Coat hangers ✗ Food-soiled aluminum foil

Do Not Include

PAPER PRODUCTS



- ✓ Newspapers/inserts
- ✓ Magazines, phone books, and catalogs
- ✓ Junk mail
- ✓ Office paper
- ✓ Paperboard (cereal and shoe boxes, etc.)
- ✓ Paperback and hardcover books

- ✓ Office paper may be placed loose in the "Office Paper" bin
- ✓ Newspaper, magazines, books and catalogs may be placed loose in the "Newspaper" bin
- ✓ Flatten paperboard boxes
- ✓ Remove foil and liners
- ✓ Remove covers on hardcover books
- ✓ Remove binders on all notebooks
- ✓ Place shredded paper in **stapled paper bags** in "Office Paper" bin

- ✗ Food-soiled paper and boxes
- ✗ Plastic bags
- ✗ Waxed or plastic-coated materials

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD



- ✓ Packaging boxes
- ✓ Clean pizza boxes
- ✓ Moving boxes

- ✓ Remove all packaging materials (packing peanuts, bubble wrap, etc.)
- ✓ Break down or cut up cardboard to fit inside bin

- ✗ Waxed cardboard
- ✗ Plastic-coated cardboard
- ✗ Soiled or stained cardboard
- ✗ Food-contaminated cardboard
- ✗ Soiled pizza boxes
- ✗ Egg cartons
- ✗ Paperboard

Drop Site Instructions



- ✓ All items must be placed in the appropriate bins.
- ✓ Read and follow all printed instructions.
- ✗ Do not leave items on the ground or outside of recycle bins.
- ✓ All items must be emptied out of plastic bags and the bags tied and placed in the plastic recycling bin.
